
Burbage can trace its history back to the 11th century, when it was valued at two shillings and gifted by Leofric, Earl of Mercia, to Coventry Abbey. Today it retains a very clear sense of identity, epitomising the traditional English village, with its splendid church and quaint, period cottages set against a backdrop of meandering streets.

There is a thriving heart to the village, with a comprehensive choice of local facilities, including a range of shops, pubs, library, doctor's surgery and infants, primary and secondary schools. A farmers' market is held on the first Saturday of the month and there is a full calendar of village events, including a carnival,


horticultural show, firework display and Christmas fayre. For lovers of the great outdoors, nearby Burbage common and woods provides a haven for birdwatchers, walkers and horse riders.


Such a tranquil rural idyll belies excellent communication links; the M69 is less than a mile away*, giving fast access to Leicester city centre (13 miles*) and the M1 and M6. The nearest railway station is at Hinckley (1.5 miles*), which connects to London Euston and St Pancras via Leicester in a little over 1.5 hours**. East Midlands Airport (28 miles*) provides regular services to worldwide destinations.






